

AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS – AVANT HEALTHCARE

- The job is a photo shoot, but for the auditions, they would like to see videos of your reactions/expressions as listed below.
- Please frame the shot as a medium shot, about mid-chest up, so the client can clearly see your face and be able to see your expressions.
- You can slate your name and agency at the beginning and then go into the expressions as listed below. (Also please show any visible tattoos/piercings, aside from pierced ears)

Background on project:

Two Products to capture. Barhemsys is a post-surgery quick acting anti-nausea medication. We want to capture the moment of rescue between a patient suffering and their relief. Byfavo is a sedation medication. We want to show the moment of sedation and the moment of waking up in recovery.

PATIENT ROLES:

- If you happen to work in healthcare in real life, please mention that in your slate. (It's not a requirement, just an added bonus)
- For the audition, would like to see you showing relief as the anti-nausea medication kicks in. And then, showing you going to sleep as the sedation/anesthesia kicks in. And finally, waking up after surgery as the anesthesia wears off.
- It's OK to ad-lib some lines if that's helpful for you.

DOCTOR/NURSE ROLES:

- If you happen to work in healthcare in real life, please mention that in your slate. (It's not a requirement, just an added bonus)
- For the audition, they'd like to see you looking concerned/compassionate. And as well, looking assertive, like you are keeping patient from throwing up post-surgery.
- It's OK to ad-lib some lines if that's helpful for you.
